- Qualifications of presenters

Proposals

Submissions should include:

- Names and titles of key proposed participant(s)
- Description of the topic of presentation
- Outline of the presentation

Selection

Submissions which include the participation of members of your chapter are highly encouraged. The national office plans to archive the presentations on our website.
